

WHITE OAK RIVER PADDLE

WHEN: SATURDAY - November 4th at 9:30 AM. If you like, join us for coffee around 8:30 at the Maysville Hardees. Around 9:00 AM or so we'll head to Dixon Field to unload and set up shuttle.

WHERE: Dixon Field Landing to Long Point

PADDLE DISTANCE: 8.75 miles, shorter option 5.75 mi. **(Anyone wanting a shorter paddle, an optional take-out is available at Hayward Landing. Trip coordinator MUST BE INFORMED prior so shuttle arrangements can be made)**

TRIP DIFFICULTY: ** EASY to MODERATE, due to length of trip and weather conditions. BE AWARE we may encounter deep or no water...downed trees...portages.

SKILL LEVEL: ** BEGINNER TO INTERMEDIATE

** Please consider your paddle abilities and weather conditions when planning for this trip. If you have any doubt, contact your trip coordinator for advice

TRIP DETAILS: This portion of the river begins narrow and winds its way through the Croatan National Forest with interesting plant and wildlife along the way. We'll take a break at Hayward Landing before continuing to Long Point. Toilet facilities are available at Dixon Field and Hayward Landing.

PROVISIONS NEEDED: Dress warmly wearing synthetics and in layers. Suitable and approved PFD must be worn. Bring a change of clothes in a dry bag and don't forget your lunch and plenty of water.

LAUNCH: No later than 10:00AM

TIME ON WATER: 3.5 hour or so. Off the water no later than 2:00PM

DIRECTIONS: (Meet at Hardees or Dixon Field Landing Put-In)

To Put-In: From New Bern take US HWY 17 South to Maysville. Turn left at traffic light and take HWY 58 toward Cape Carteret. Go 3.8 miles and turn right on Hwy 58 Loop Road (SR 1102). From there you will be going .33 miles and turning right on Dixon Field Road and when you get to a Stop Sign turn right again and go to the end. This is a dirt/gravel Forest Service Rd.
