

Cahoogue Creek kayak Trip

Saturday November 11, 2017

This trip can be paddled as a beginner trip or an intermediate trip due to the distance & exposure options. We will meet at the Cahoogue Creek Wildlife Landing on Saturday and **depart** at 10:00 am to paddle up the Cahoogue Creek (very sheltered creek) for a couple of miles and then return to Hancock Creek near our put in around 11:30. You can take out there or continue paddling downstream on Hancock Creek (more open but still fairly sheltered waters) for a couple of miles to the mouth of the Neuse River where we will have a lunch break at a nice sandy beach. We should be back by around 2:00 pm., Depending on how long we take for lunch.

Directions to put in: Take Highway 70 East to Havelock and veer left on to Highway 101 to the Cahoogue Creek Road on the left (Just before the N.C. Ferry Road). Go to the end of Cahoogue Rd. and take the dirt road on the left to the end where you will come to the landing.

Life jackets must be worn on all TRPC trips. Bring a lunch & water if paddling to the river.
