

Washington Waterfront Paddle

WHEN: Saturday, June 9, 2018 – Arrive 9:30 A.M., Launch around 10:00 A.M.

WHERE: Washington, NC

PADDLE DISTANCE: Approximately 8 miles TIME ON WATER: 3 ½ to 4 hrs.

TRIP DIFFICULTY: ** Moderate ** due to some open river water, wind and/or current. Please consider your paddle abilities and weather conditions when planning for this trip. If you have any concerns, contact trip coordinator for advice.

SKILL REQUIREMENTS: Intermediate **

TRIP DETAILS: Join other paddlers for an exploration paddle trip along the Washington NC waterfront. This paddle will take us upstream on the Pamlico River past the waterfront of Little Washington. We will paddle under the railroad bridge and both the old and new Hwy 17 bridges before arriving at a small island where we can take a short break. From here, we can either continue upstream or leisurely return exploring the opposite shore back to the take-out. At the conclusion of our paddle, participants are welcome to join us for a bite to eat (TBD) in Washington, before returning home.

PROVISIONS NEEDED: A type II or III PFD must be worn and properly secured, dress for conditions. Snacks, sunscreen and plenty of water are suggested.

LAUNCH: Around 10:00 AM

SHUTTLE: None required.

DIRECTIONS: Put-in will be at the Runyon Creek boat ramp across from Inner Banks Outfitter, 1050E. Main Street, Washington, NC.
