

SLOCUM CREEK PADDLE

WHEN: SATURDAY - April 7th at 9:30 AM.

WHERE: Slocum Creek, Havelock NC

PADDLE DISTANCE: 4-5 miles

TRIP DIFFICULTY: ** EASY to MODERATE

SKILL LEVEL: ** BEGINNER TO INTERMEDIATE

** Please consider your paddle abilities and weather conditions when planning for this trip. If you have any concerns, contact trip coordinator for advice

TRIP DETAILS: We'll begin by exploring the upper reaches of Slocum's Southwest Prong, then paddle out into the main section of the creek for a mile or two before returning.

PROVISIONS NEEDED: Dress warmly wearing synthetics and in layers. Suitable and approved PFD must be worn and don't forget a snack and plenty of water.

LAUNCH: No later than 10:00AM TIME ON WATER: 2-3 hour or so.

DIRECTIONS: From New Bern, take RT 70 East to Havelock. Slocum Creek boat ramp is off service road [next to Havelock Tourist Center]
