MEETING MINUTES June 12, 2018

7:00pm: Secretary Corinne Everett Belch welcomed all; 16 members in attendance.

Treasurer: Our account balance is currently \$2781.14, we have 90 member households.

Secretary: Corinne reported that the May minutes had been sent out; Bill Sadler motioned to accept the minutes, seconded by Terry Rich. The motion passed unanimously.

Craven County Parks and Recreation: Mark Seymour thanked everyone for helping with the beginners class and has turned in request for money for that; this year was the largest class ever. Typically 80% of the beginners class registration fee goes to the club and 20% goes to Craven County Parks and Recreation. In the past the TRPC has given some of our 80% of the fee to Sound Rivers. For 2018 the total going to the club will be \$540. Ellie Toombs made a motion to give the entire balance of \$540 to Sound Rivers, Bill Sadler seconded. Without objections, motion carried.

Mark also reported that the Creekside kayak launch needs repairs; will check on what needs to be done and bring to consideration of club for financing.

The Craven County employee wellness paddle went well, 15 people went out on the water and everyone had a good time.
